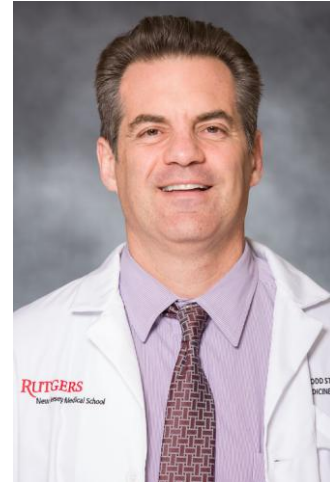

TODD P. STITIK MD, RMSK



Todd P. Stitik, M.D., RMSK is a Professor of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation at Rutgers- New Jersey Medical School. He is the Director of Outpatient Musculoskeletal/ Occupational Medicine, Co-Director of the Osteoarthritis and Interventional Pain Management Clinic, and co-director of the Musculoskeletal Medicine/Interventional Pain Management fellowship for the Department of PM&R at New Jersey Medical School.

Dr. Stitik has been performing and teaching musculoskeletal ultrasound as part of his clinical-academic practice since 2007. He teaches in musculoskeletal ultrasound courses annually for the AAPM&R, the Jefferson Ultrasound Institute, the Cooper Health System Rheumatology Dept, the ACOPMR and for MSKUS.

Dr. Stitik is an article reviewer for the Journal of Ultrasound in Medicine, and is a committee chairperson for the ARDMS involved with revising the physician musculoskeletal ultrasound examination.

Dr. Stitik attended college at Rutgers University, followed by medical school at the University of Pennsylvania. He then completed an Internal Medicine residency at NYU and a Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation Medicine Residency at Rutgers, New Jersey Medical School-Kessler Institute of Rehabilitation. He is board-certified in Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, and subspecialty board-certified in Pain Medicine, Electrodiagnostic Medicine, and Musculoskeletal Ultrasound.
