

## Curriculum Vitae

- Stéphane Grijseels was born on October 18, 1960 in Brussels, Belgium.
- After completing his secondary education at the “Koninklijk Atheneum” in his hometown in Geraadsbergen (Belgium) in 1978, he studied medicine at the Flemish University of Brussels, Belgium, and obtained his medical degree in 1986.
- He then became a radiology resident at the Flemish University Hospital of Brussels (Belgium) and obtained his specialist registration in 1990.
- After working 4 more years at the same University Hospital, he did a Musculoskeletal Radiology fellowship at The Hospital for Joint Diseases (New York, USA) from 1994 to 1995, followed by a Radiology Residency at The University Medical Center of Mississippi (Jackson, USA) for a four year period (1995 – 1999).
- After successfully completing the required examinations, he obtained the certificate “Diplomate of the American Board of Radiology” at the same institution.
- Afterwards he did another fellowship in Interventional Radiology at The University of Maryland (Baltimore, USA) from 1999-2000.
- Then he worked for 12 years in private practice as a staff focusing on Musculoskeletal and Interventional radiology.
- Afterwards he was appointed as staff radiologist at the Flemish University Hospital in Brussels, Belgium (2012-2016) focusing on musculoskeletal imaging.
- Recently, since April 2016, he is employed as a staff musculoskeletal radiologist at the University Hospital of Leuven (Belgium)
